

Expectations for students returning to/visiting school

- Parents must exercise caution and not send students to school if they have a temperature or any other Covid symptoms. If you are not sure about these, please refer to the NHS website, <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/check-if-you-have-coronavirus-symptoms/>
- Parents cannot come into the school with students. Parents will not be admitted so that we can enforce social distancing in Visitors' Reception.

Keyworker students and other students being supervised by staff for the day

- Students should not meet or arrive with other students.
- Students will not be allowed to wait in school or outside school for other students.
- On arrival at Visitor Reception all students must sanitise their hands. They will then be directed to a seat in the school dining hall
- They be guided to either the Library or C6, where they will spend most of the day.
- They will be allocated a workstation for the day
- Students must exercise social distancing (2m) from other students and staff
- If students need to use a toilet, they need to ask permission and will be allowed to Yr. 7 toilets individually
- Students are not allowed to go anywhere else in school unless they have been given permission by a member of staff
- At lunch time , the students will eat outside as long as the weather is good, maintaining social distance
- When moving around the school, students should follow the one-way route as directed by staff

Academic Tutoring appointments

- Each student will be given a specific timed appointment.
- Students must stick to the time given and arrive on time so we can ensure social distancing measures are in place.
- If students do not arrive on time, we will not be able to see them, due to the current government guidance for student and teacher safety.
- Students should not meet or arrive with other students.
- Students will not be allowed to wait in school or outside school for other students.
- On arrival all students must sanitise their hands. They will then be directed to a seat in the school dining hall
- Students will only be going as far as their assigned classroom and accompanied by a member of staff at all times. Students are not allowed to go anywhere else in school
- If students need to use a toilet, they need to ask permission and will be taken by a member of staff to the Yr. 11 toilets opposite C3.
- Students must exercise social distancing (2m) from other students and staff
- When moving around the school, students should follow the one-way route as directed by staff

We have worked hard to make arrangements which will protect students and staff and which are easy to follow. If any student refuses to do as asked by a member of staff, they will be asked to leave the premises. The School's behaviour policy and the attached addendum will apply as usual.
